APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

Undergraduate and postgraduate application forms for admission can be downloaded from the college's official website. Candidates are advised to visit the website (www.sthinducollege.com) to access the prospectus and instructions for completing the online application process. Applicants must fill out and submit their applications exclusively through the online mode. Offline applications will not be accepted.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

- For admission to U.G. courses, preference will be given to candidates aged between 17 and
 years who have successfully passed all examinations on their first attempt.
- 2. Admission to B.Sc. degree courses is limited to candidates who have studied the relevant subjects at the HSC level.
- 3. For B.Com. admission, preference will be given to candidates who have studied Accountancy and Commerce at the HSC level (Academic Stream).
- 4. Students applying for undergraduate courses must choose at least one extension activity (NCC, NSS, or Youth Red Cross).
- 5. The eligibility criteria for admission to P.G. Science courses are a minimum of 40% marks for Scheduled Castes and Tribes in Part III subjects, and 45% for candidates from other communities.
- 6. College Operating Hours: 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- 7. Dress Code: Uniforms are mandatory for all students, except Ph.D. scholars.
- 8. Admission of candidates who have not passed the TN Higher Secondary Examination is provisional and subject to the university's approval.
- 9. Candidates found to have obtained admission through false representation will be summarily dismissed, and all fees paid will be forfeited.
- 10. Use of cell phones within the college campus is strictly prohibited.

CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION

- 1. Admissions will be conducted through a counselling process.
- 2. The maximum age limit for admission to U.G. courses is 21 years as of June 1, 2025. Age relaxations are available as follows:
 - o SC/ST/BC/MBC/DNC/Women and Transgender candidates: 3 years
 - Physically handicapped candidates: 5 years
- 3. The following scanned documents must be uploaded along with the completed online application form:
 - i. Mark sheet of the qualifying examination
 - ii. Community certificate
 - iii. Certificate of proof for special quotas or concessions (e.g., Physically Handicapped, Sports, Ex-Serviceman, NCC, etc.)
 - iv. Income certificate
- 4. Applications for U.G. and P.G. courses must be submitted within 10 days of the publication

- of the Higher Secondary or M.S. University degree examination results. The registration slip must be presented for any inquiries regarding the application.
- 5. Candidates and their parents/guardians must appear before the Principal on the scheduled counseling date and time, as indicated on the college website. All original documents must be produced at the time of the interview.
- 6. If admission is confirmed, the prescribed fees must be paid immediately after the interview; otherwise, the seat will be forfeited. Candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes/Tribes, M.B.C., and Denotified Communities are exempted from paying tuition and special fees at the time of admission if they produce the relevant certificates. Their fees will be deducted from their scholarship.
- 7. Any grievances regarding the admission process should be addressed to the Joint Director of Collegiate Education, Tirunelveli.
- N.B. Incomplete Application Forms will be summarily rejected.

RULE OF RESERVATION

Admissions are made purely on the basis of Merit in accordance with the rule of reservation of the

Government of Tamil Nadu.

- 1) 31% for Open Competition (OC)
- 2) 20% for Most Backward Class (MBC) and Denotified Communities (DNC)
- 3) 30% for Backward Classes (BC), within this 3.5% for Muslims.
- 4) 18% for Scheduled Castes (SC), within this 3% of seats are offered to Arunthathiyar.
- 5) 1% for Scheduled Tribes (ST).

- 1. Application for admission to the hostel shall be made in the prescribed form to the Principal, the warden of the hostel. Every student on admission to the hostel shall pay Rs.100/- as admission fee, Rs.100 as warden fund, Rs.200/- as Hostel Day contribution, Rs.4000/- as Caution Deposit, Rs.1500 as water, light and establishment charges and Rs.2000 as Room Rent per semester.
- 2. If the required number of students are admitted in the Hostel, the mess will be run on dividing system. The monthly mess charges will be about Rs.3000/- to 3500/-. Both vegetarian and non-vegetarian meals will be provided.
- 3. Every student admitted to the hostel must scrupulously abide by the rules of the hostel.
- 4. Separate hostel is available for Girls.
